
2016 national rally in the Heart of New York's Finger Lakes

The campground for our six-night rally is Hickory Hill Family Camping Resort, Bath, New York. The campground is holding 70 full hook-up 50-amp sites, complete with cable and WiFi available, just for us! Hickory Hills is a large resort with a variety of camping areas, just on the outskirts of Bath, N.Y., at the foot of Keuka Lake (see red dot on map on right).

Rally dates are September 19 (in) through September 25 (out), 2016. However, we are opening the time frame for three nights early – September 16, 17 and 18 – and three nights late – September 25, 26 and 27 (out September 28). All early and late days will be at the rally parking rate, so you could be spending a total of 12 nights in the Heart of the Finger Lakes

The rally is really still in the planning stage, but with only 70 sites available and a very early and strict registration closing date, we want you to have as much information now as possible. So, with that being said, **the last date to register will be August 15, 2016.** We are handling **ALL** registrations including the early dates of September 16-18, as well as the late dates of September 25-27. **PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE PARK**.

Why the early and late days? Is there enough to keep you busy? Yes! So much, in fact, that we are not planning tours; there will be golf (details to follow), and we are working on a farmers market, crafts, and cooking at the RV park with some of the treats of the area. souvenir. Corning also is the home to the Rockwell Museum, which features the art of the American experience, plus a collection of historic firearms. Just steps away is the Gaffer District, a brick sidewalk area in charming downtown Corning, where you will find boutiques, antique stores, specialty shops, galleries, and restaurants.



In Penn Yan, you will find the Windmill Farm & Craft Market (www.thewindmill.com), only open

on Saturdays, with many of the items made by the Amish and Windmill Farm & Craft Market Mennonite people in the area. \rightarrow

← Hammondsport is where you will find the Glenn Curtiss Museum, "Where Biplanes Soared and Motorcycles Roared" (www.glenncurtissmuseum.org). Glenn Curtiss

was an inventor of 87 U.S. patents, held the motorcycle speed record, and made the first U.S. city-to-city flight. There is so much more is on display here.

Watkins Glen (www.watkinsglenchamber.com/) is home to one of the many state parks in the area. The park has a 400 ft. descend and 200 ft. cliffs, with 19 waterfalls, all within a two-mile walking trail. You will also find Watkins Glen International race track, where NASCAR, Grand-Am, and SCCA Trans-Am, just to name a few of the major races are held. \rightarrow

On the four largest Finger Lakes – Canandaigua, Cayuga, Keuka and Seneca – you will find over 100 wineries, eight breweries, ciders and distillery's. You are also less than a day's drive from Alexandria Bay, the 1000 Islands, the St Lawrence Seaway, Lake Ontario, Niagara Falls, and Fort Drum.
